From 1 April 2015,

we are launching a new urgent care service available to everyone across Scarborough and Ryedale.

The new service operates 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

It is provided from two urgent care centres, one located at Scarborough Hospital and one at Malton Hospital. Home visits are also provided where appropriate.

The best way to access this service is by **calling 111**. They will give you an appointment (if appropriate) to attend an Urgent Care Centre to reduce the time you have to wait at the centre.

Alternatively, you can simply go to one of the centres during opening hours and wait to be seen.

REMEMBER The walk-in service at Castle Health Centre will no longer operate from **1** April **2015**

Scarborough Urgent Care Centre Scarborough Hospital, Woodlands Drive, YO12 6QL

The urgent care centre in Scarborough is open 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. To save you having to wait, call 111 and they will give you a time to attend.

Malton Urgent Care Centre Malton Hospital, Middlecave Road, YO17 7NG

The urgent care centre in Malton is open from 9am to 8pm, 365 days a year. Outside of these times you can still call 111 and they will arrange for someone to see you at Malton Urgent Care Centre.
