

<b>Pathway:</b>	Paediatric Foot problems – Curly Toes
<b>Referral Criteria/Commissioning position:</b>	
<p><i>Refer if:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• deformity is severe, as is shown by either deformity of the growing nail of the toe or pressure on the adjacent toe or corn formation on the dorsum of the toe</li> <li>• there is significant pain</li> </ul> <p>All patients to be referred to podiatry services prior to referral to secondary care</p>	
<b>Information to include in referral letter:</b>	
<p><i>The GP referral letter should contain:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Details of how the patient meets the above criteria</li> <li>• Treatments tried already and their effects</li> <li>• Past medical/surgical history</li> <li>• Current regular medication</li> <li>• BMI</li> <li>• Smoking status</li> <li>• Alcohol consumption</li> </ul>
