

<b>Pathway:</b>	Paediatric Foot problems – Metatarsus Varus (Metatarsus Adductus)
<b>Referral Criteria/Commissioning position:</b>	
<p><i>Refer to secondary care if:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• after the child reaches the age of 5 years the in-toeing is still evident as surgery may necessary</li> </ul> <p><b>All patients to be referred to local podiatry services prior to referral to secondary care</b></p>	
<b>Information to include in referral letter:</b>	
<p><i>The GP referral letter should contain:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Description of symptoms and duration</li> <li>• Details of treatments and measures tried including outcomes</li> <li>• Drug history (prescribed and non-prescribed)</li> <li>• Relevant past medical/surgical history</li> <li>• Current regular medication</li> <li>• BMI</li> <li>• Smoking status</li> <li>• Alcohol consumption</li> </ul>
